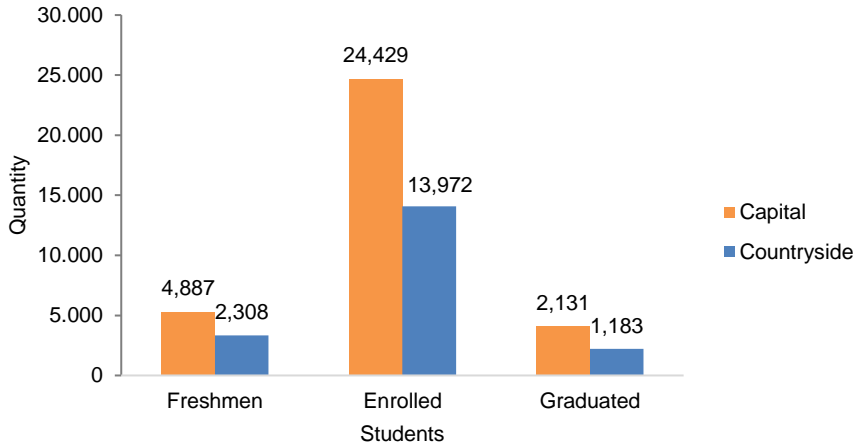

Graph 1 – Quantitative undergraduate students per location in 2021



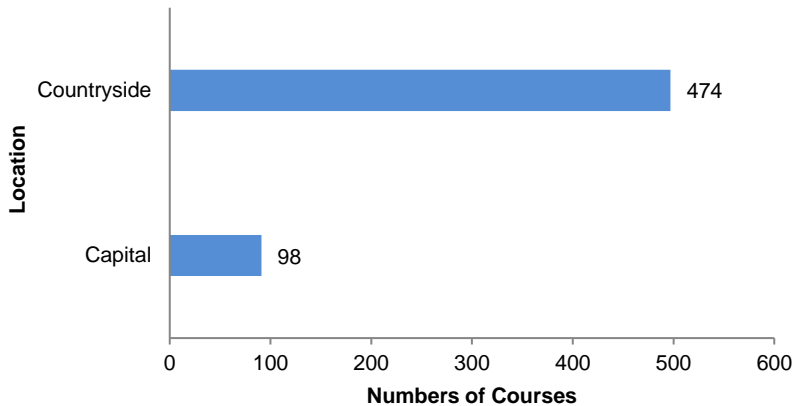

Graph 3 - Quantitative postgraduate students, per course/level in 2021

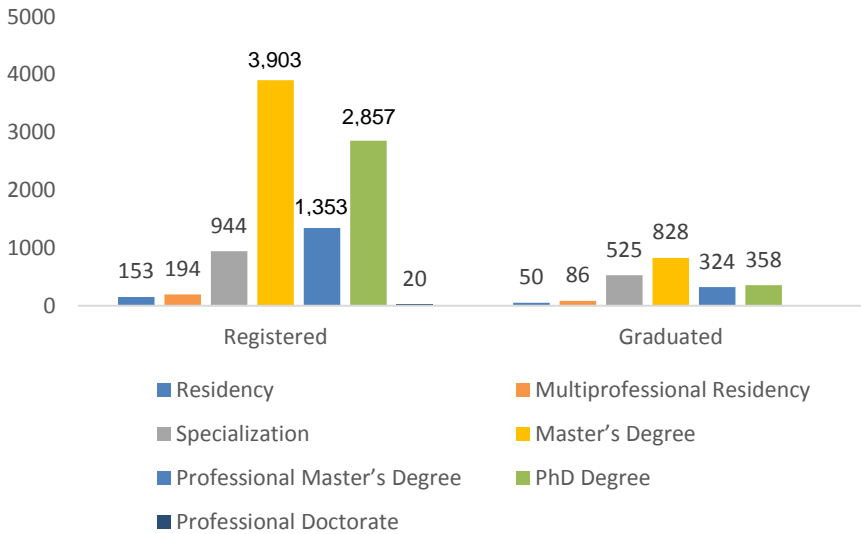

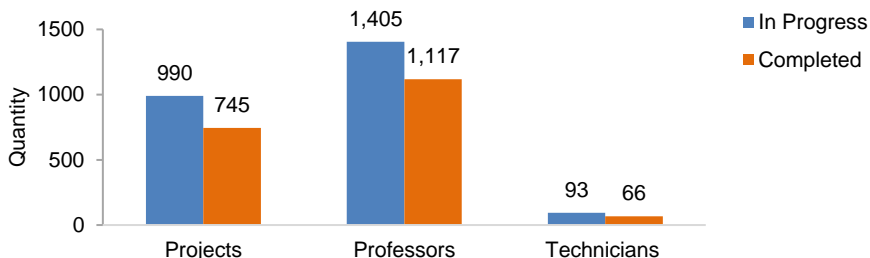

Graph 5 - Percentage of effective higher education professors by schooling/titles in 2021

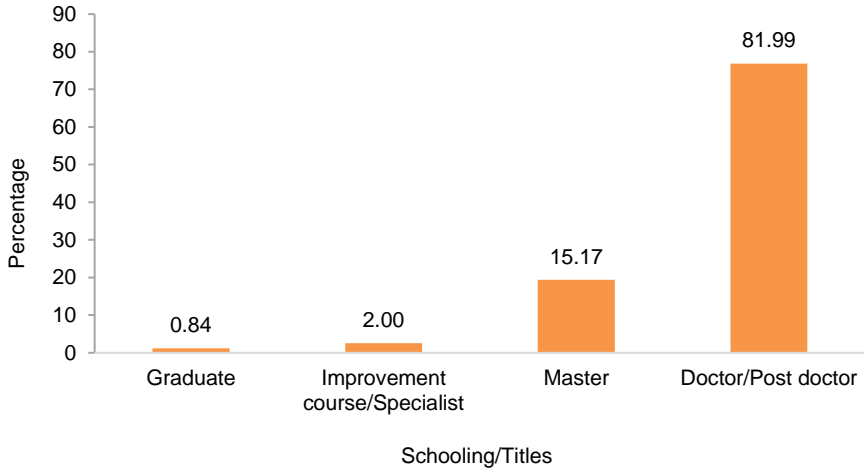

Graph 6 - Percentage of effective teachers from basic education by schooling/ titles in 2021

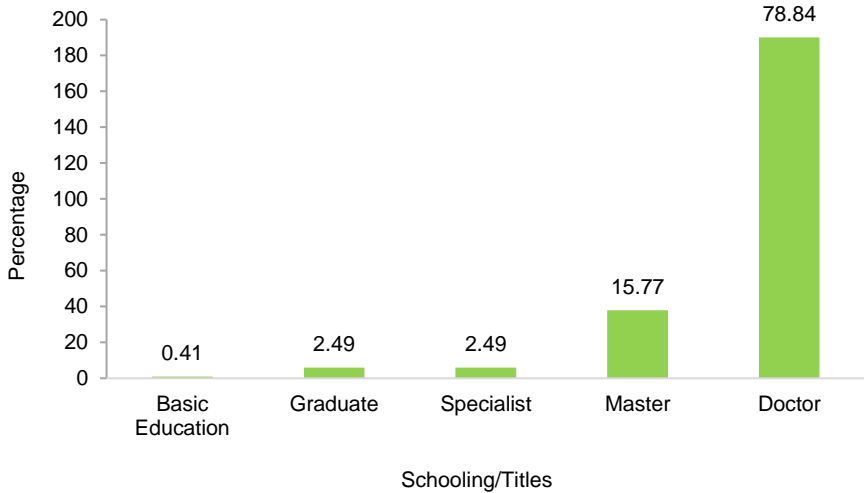

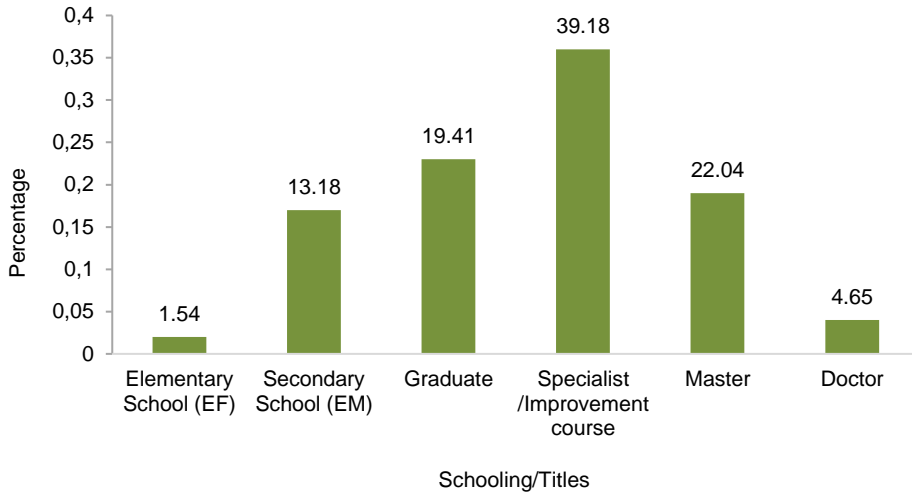
