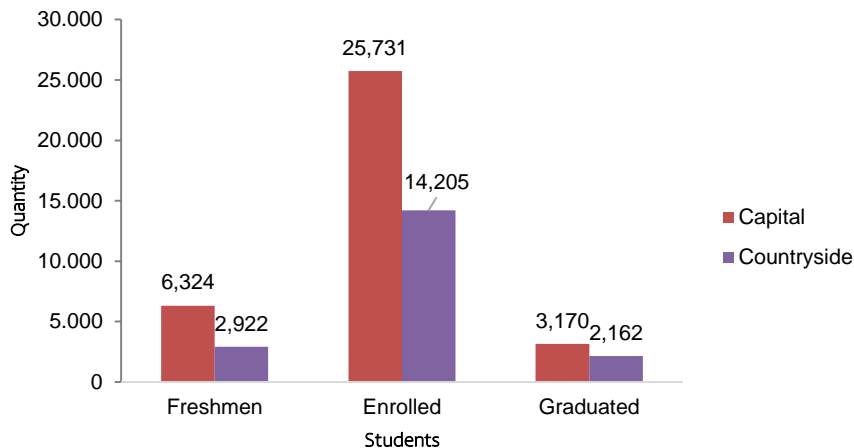

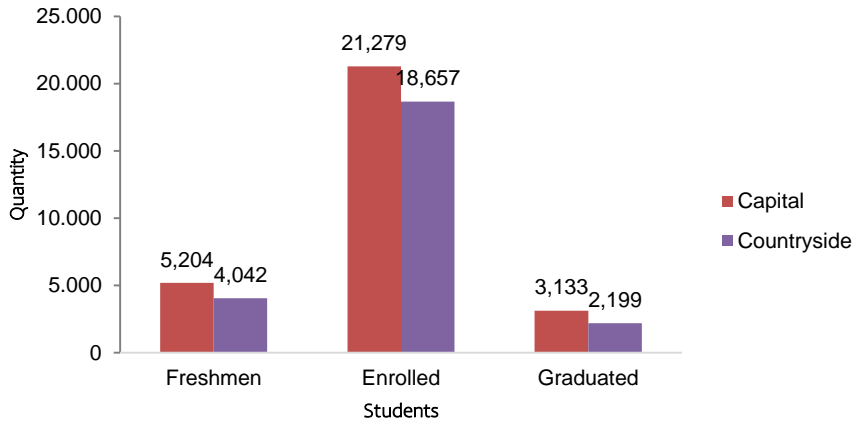

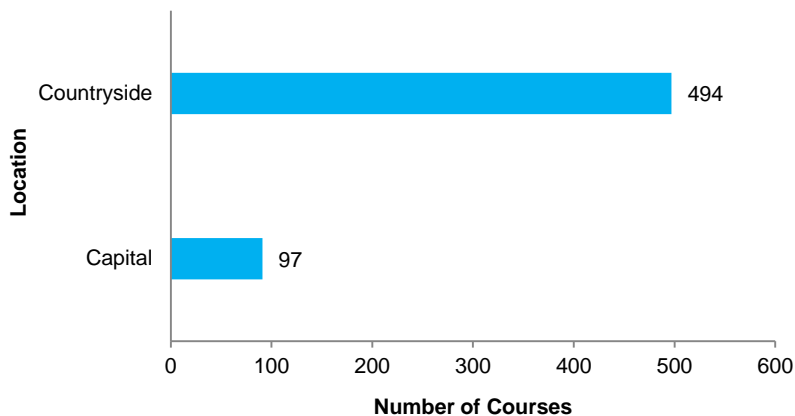

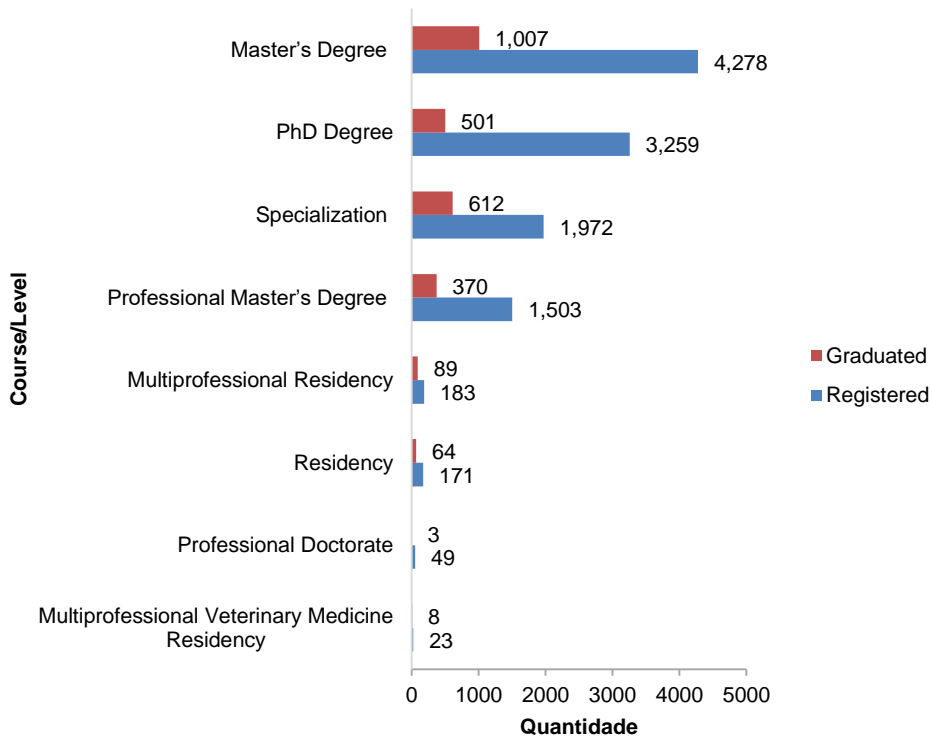

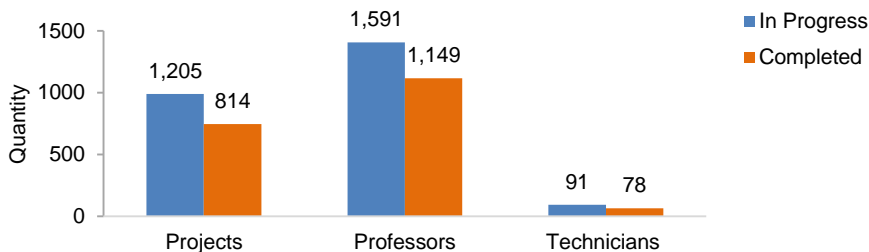

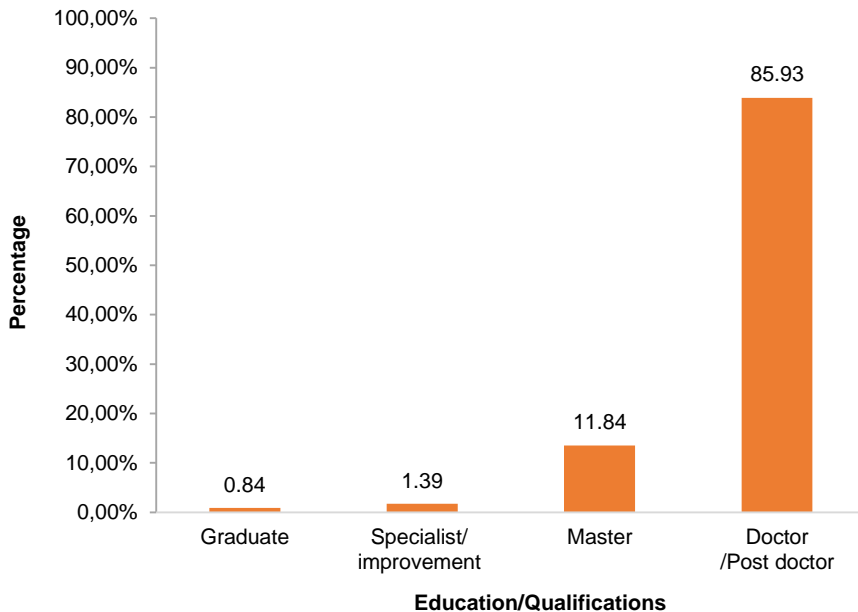

Graph 6 - Percentage of permanent higher education professors by education/qualifications in 2023



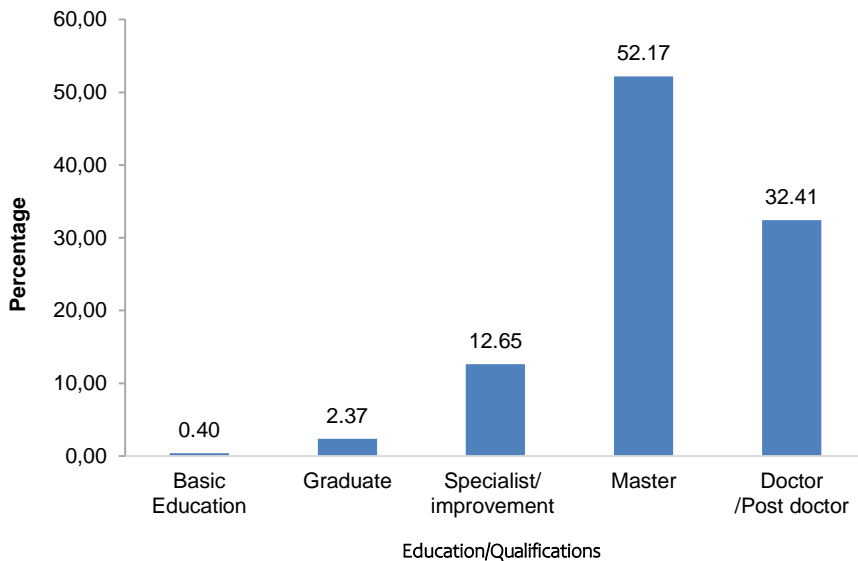

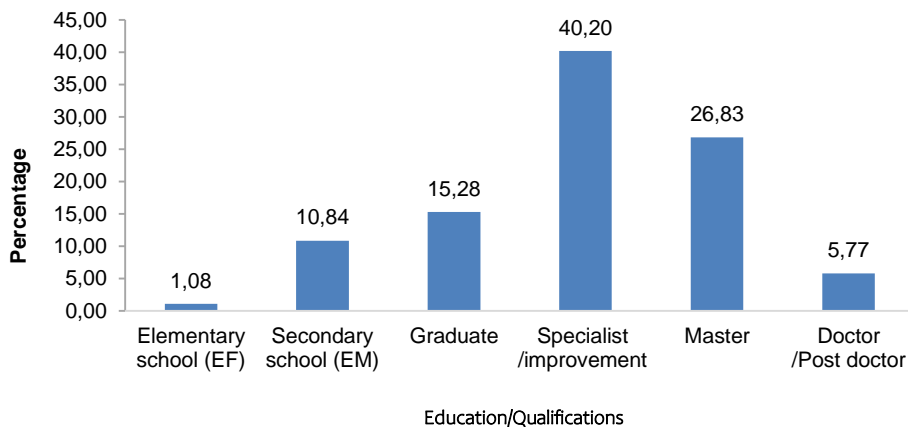
